'I buy the plays and fix them up and put my name on them.' Who gets the royalties? 'I get the royalties.' I left the office and went over and joined the Dramatists Guild."

Much has changed since those heady days but much has not. The theatre still remains one of the few places where the work of the writer is respected and protected in large part thanks to the efforts of our Guild.
